Membership fee is payable annually – **debit order system** is available which makes it very affordable. Membership is voluntary.

Membership is per branch or franchise. Every branch in every region pays separately for membership. SAPCA membership period runs from **1st of July to the end of June**.

Members are all **listed on the SAPCA website** with their contact details in regions. Woodborer inspectors are listed separately under the woodborer section.

Woodborer inspectors can make use of SAPCA clearance certificate with a three month warranty. Clearance certificates can be ordered to use **online** on the website or **per book**.

SAPCA members get **discount** on all training courses done by the PCSIB, any Conferences and other projects.

SAPCA provides its members with ongoing information through a **3 monthly electronic Newsletter, monthly E-News, monthly SAPCA Bulletin**.

SAPCA also has its own **Facebook page, Twitter, YouTube**.

SAPCA organises three **monthly meetings** in all regions where members can attend and participate.
