## How to identify;

### Legitimate vacancies from Scams

There are many illegal/fake work opportunities posted and shared on social media. Familiarize yourself with the applicable legislation and facts.

- A legitimate position advertised will NOT ask you to comment (yes, your location or address) on the post.
- A legitimate company will NOT ask you to WhatsApp them via Facebook, but will request a CV for application by means of email.

- A legitimate employer will never ask for a fee from a jobseeker.

### Refer to The Employment Services Act, 2014 Clause 15

- Be alert when they offer free internet data.
- Avoid random links and be careful to forward links without proper verification.
